PLEASE ASK ONE OF THE SIDESPERSONS, WHO WILL BE HAPPY TO ASSIST YOU. *THE FIRST PRAYER BOOK EXHORTATION ENCOURAGES US TO RECEIVE THE SACRAMENT IN FAITH AND REPENTANCE, 'DISCERNING THE LORD'S BODY.'*
